1.5 DISCUSSION: DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS AND DEVELOPING A PERMIT PROCESS

[RE:--Engineer for Dimmit County **Daniel Hejl** addressed court members w/ issues about standards for basic things to develop a consistency across each precinct and the importance of input from the court on their ideas and concepts to reach a uniform ROW for drainage:

- 1) include in policy...bridges w/additional ROW
- 2) bond for assurance that a contractor does not leave before finishing the job
- 3) fixing "colonias" to city standards
- 4) (from) County Attorney : --that the contractor make first contact before proceeding w/work; this allows the liability to be placed on them---after completion of work that the contractor notify the commissioner so that he may don an inventory of the roadway (ex: curves, signage, existing pavement, driveways etc)

Hejl also shared copy of Requirements for Williamson County Utilities Installation Permit, i.e., application, liability agreement Developing a Public Private Partnership (PPP)

- 5) 8 compacted to 6" thickness and minimum of 28' wide section lane w/ shoulders a priority for ROW]
