

ADVISORY NOTICE OF CONTINUING PETITION PERIOD

RELATED TO

DIMMIT COUNTY, TEXAS COMBINATION TAX AND LIMITED PLEDGE REVENUE
CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION, SERIES 2020 (the “Certificates”)

TAKE NOTICE from the Commissioners Court (the “Court”) of Dimmit County, Texas (the “County”), that the petition period related to the Certificates provided under Section 271.049 of the Texas Local Government Code is continuing, open and remains effective. Based on the provisions of Section 271.049, this petition period for the Certificates provides that if the County receives a petition signed by at least five percent of the qualified voters of the County protesting the issuance of the Certificates, the County will not issue the Certificates unless the issuance is approved at an election ordered, held, and conducted in the manner provided for bond elections under Chapter 1251, Government Code. The Court will convene in its regular meeting place in the Dimmit County Courthouse at 10:00 A.M on December 1, 2020 and will consider the passage of an order to approve, ratify, and confirm the authorizing and issuance of the Certificates initially approved at the September 28, 2020 regular meeting of the Court, which was the date tentatively set for approval as stated in the Notice of Intention to Issue Certificates of Obligation which was published in two consecutive week on August 12, 2020 and August 19, 2020. Such Notice in attached hereto as Exhibit “A” for the convenience of the public. The petition period related to the Certificates remains effective until the later of the adoption of an Order, ratifying the original sale of the Certificates, scheduled to be adopted on December 1, 2020 or further notice of the Court.

The Certificates are to be issued under and pursuant to the provisions of the Certificate of Obligation Act of 1971, as amended, Local Government Code Section 271.041 through Section 271.064, and Section 363.135, as amended, Texas Health and Safety Code.

EXHIBIT A

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE
DIMMIT COUNTY, TEXAS CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Commissioners Court (the "Court") of Dimmit County, Texas (the "County") will convene at its regular meeting place at the Dimmit County Courthouse, 212 North 4th Street, Carrizo Springs, Texas, at 10:00 o'clock a.m., on September 28, 2020, and, during such meeting, the Court will consider the passage of an order and take such other actions as may be deemed necessary to authorize the issuance of one or more series of certificates of obligation in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.00 for the purpose or purposes of paying contractual obligations of the County to be incurred, to-wit: (1) construction, repair and improvements to County roads and bridges (including the purchase of land and equipment), and amenities incident thereof, (2) purchase of office equipment and technology upgrades for County Departments, (3) construction, renovation, utility improvements, and equipment of County Buildings for County Departments (including the purchase of land, as needed) and (4) the payment of professional services related to the construction and financing of the aforementioned projects.

The certificates of obligation (the "Certificates") will be payable from the levy of an annual ad valorem tax, within the limitations prescribed by law, upon all taxable property within the County and additionally from a limited pledge of certain revenues derived from the operation of the County's solid waste management system. The Certificates are to be issued, and this notice is given, under and pursuant to the provisions of the Certificate of Obligation Act of 1971 as amended, Local Government Code Sections 271.041 through 271.063, and Section 363.135, as amended, Texas Health and Safety Code.

The current principal of all outstanding debt obligations of the County is \$13,465,000. The combined principal and interest required to pay all outstanding debt obligations of the County on time and in full is \$13,794,936. The estimated combined principal and interest required to pay the Certificates is \$5,117,944.44. The estimated interest rate for the Certificates is 2.000%. The maximum interest rate for the certificates may not exceed the maximum legal interest rate. The maximum maturity date of the Certificates is September 1, 2022.
